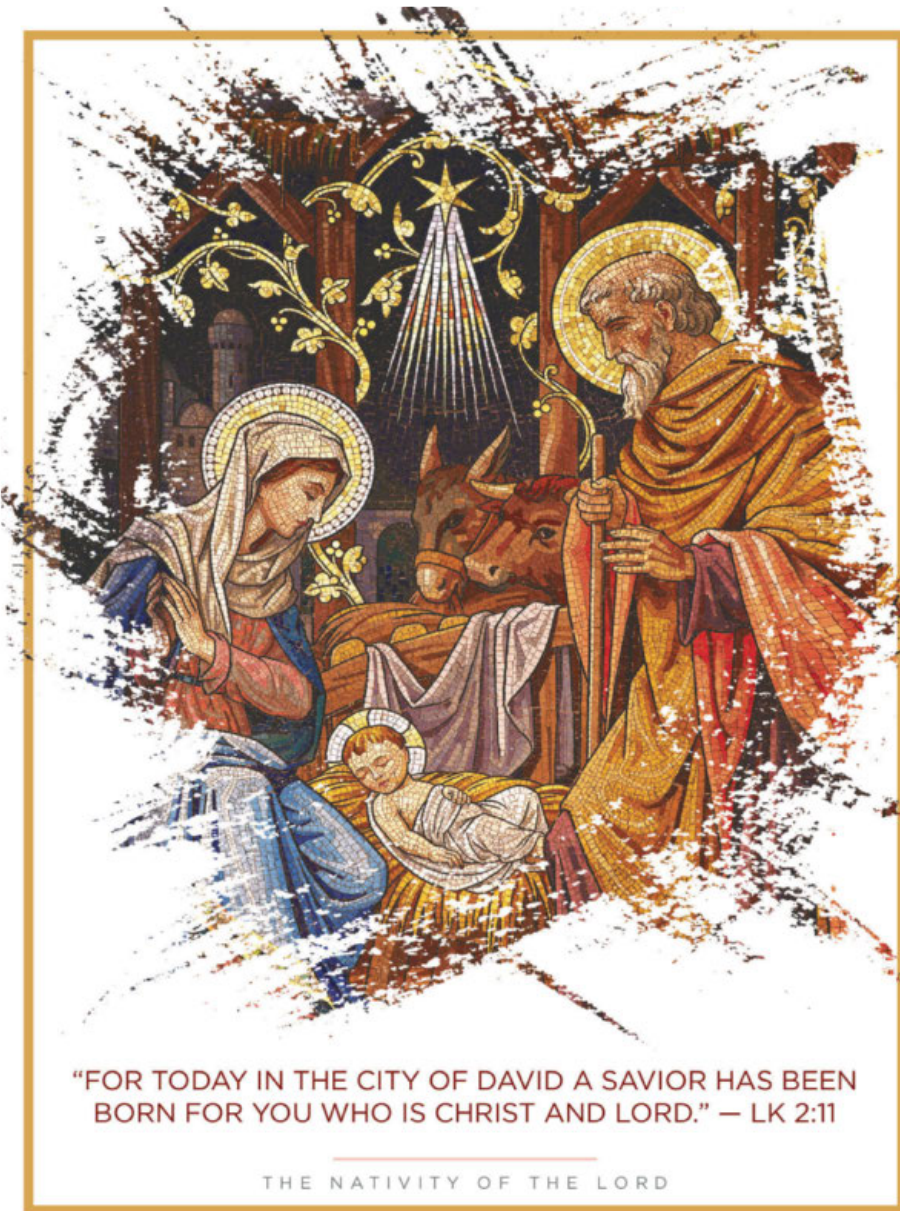

This year, Christmas Day and the Fourth Sunday of Advent are both days of precept and they both have the same rank in the Table of Liturgical Days.

Therefore, we have two obligations to fulfill – we must go to two distinct Masses.

The fulfillment of the Mass obligation does not depend upon the Mass prayers and readings but rather on the time of day at which one attends Mass. According to canon 1248 §1, "A person who assists at a Mass celebrated anywhere in a Catholic rite either on the feast day itself or in the evening of the preceding day satisfies the obligation of participating in the Mass."
