

## **SYNOD LISTENING SESSIONS, WHAT** WE LEARNED AND WHAT'S NEXT...

A big thank you to all who took part in Synod Listening Sessions and the recent Ministry Fair. Meeting and talking with you was a pleasure! While the Church prepares for the October 2024 Synod meeting in Rome, churches all over the world are charged with building on what was learned thus far. More than 280 parishioners participated in the First Phase of the Synod. The results of our listening showed immense joy about our common faith, and the beauty of our liturgical celebrations. There is much gratitude for a welcoming, nourishing, compassionate community, and for the large variety of ministries and opportunities to serve—and especially for all those whose volunteering makes that possible.

Our parish report is available in the Gathering Space and on the parish website. Here is a very quick synopsis of some of the many suggestions for things to pursue on the parish level. Participants shared ideas, hopes, and dreams about even more ways we can spread the joy of belonging and engagement to others. Some of the ideas included having more activities for college-bound students and young adults, families and children; cultural sharing; contemporary music gatherings (drop-in jam sessions or formal groups); more listening sessions; and, individual and/or group spiritual direction. More people are needed to make these dreams come true. Please take time to listen, to pray, to dialog, and to discern where the Holy Spirit is leading. We are the church, and all our talents are needed whether in small ways or large. If you didn't have a chance to talk with Synod Committee members at the Ministry Fair, please call or email us if you would like to attend committee meetings or want more information. We sincerely hope that you will find a way that feels just right for you to help our parish "widen our tent."
