



HOW IS DIOCESAN APPEAL REVENUE USED? DIOCESAN APPEAL -- 2023-24, UPDATED APRIL 8

30 Diocesan departments are staffed by 57 full-time & 23 part-time individuals with expertise in specialties such as those of the Tribunal, religious education, human resources, facilities management, finance & accounting, prayer and worship, etc. The bulk of department budgets is staffing. Additionally, the Appeal provides full funding of seminarian education, underwriting of the administration of Catholic Schools, & support of the programs of Catholic Charities for those who face food insecurity & hunger. 
