City Mission

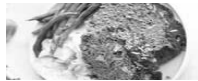
The City Mission is looking for personal hygiene items of small bars of soap and used old towels (not new). There will be a bin in the back of church to place the items in.

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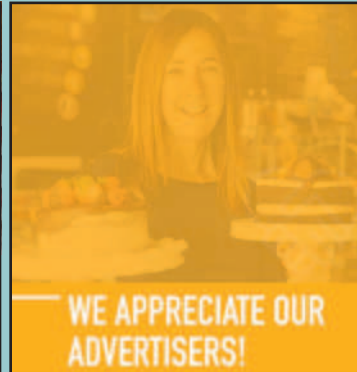
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
