Adult Baptism and Confirmation Information

Session : Any baptized Christian adult interested in completing their initiation into the Catholic Church, as well as any unbaptized adult interesting in finding out more about being baptized in the Catholic church, is encouraged to attend an information session on **Sunday November 9th following 10:30 AM Mass**. For those seeking baptism, we will discuss the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, which culminates in the catechumens receiving all sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) at the Easter Vigil Mass in April. For those Christians already baptized, tailored programs will begin in December leading to Confirmation and full communion with the church on Pentecost Sunday in May. High food and gas prices and unemployment are squeezing families, sending many to food pantries for the first time.

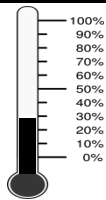
Meanwhile our pantries are struggling with inflation costs, supply chain woes and fewer donations coming in.
