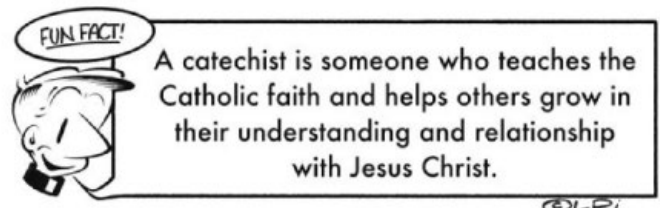

## American Clothing Blue Box

Did you know...?

The blue clothing drop boxes at St. Joseph's and St. Paul's raise funds on a year round basis, without the need of volunteers. The parish is paid 5 cents per pound for clothing and shoes collected; averaging \$50-\$100 per month, for each church.

The clothing is sent throughout the U.S. and to third world countries to be re-worn, where new clothing is unaffordable for many of it's citizens. **Usable clothing is not shredded**

Locally, American Clothing supports these organizations and disaster relief efforts Glens Falls Hospital: Communities Against Cancer, Regional Food Bank of NENY, Albany Medical Center, Catholic Charities, NE Parent & Child, American Red Cross, Center for Disability Services, Parsons Child & Family Center.

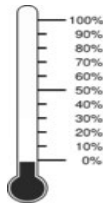
