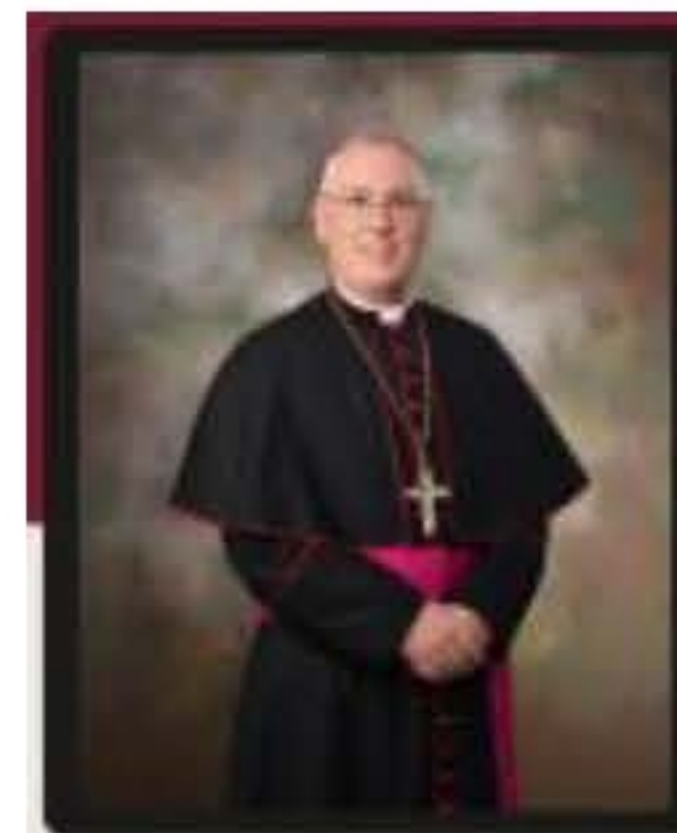

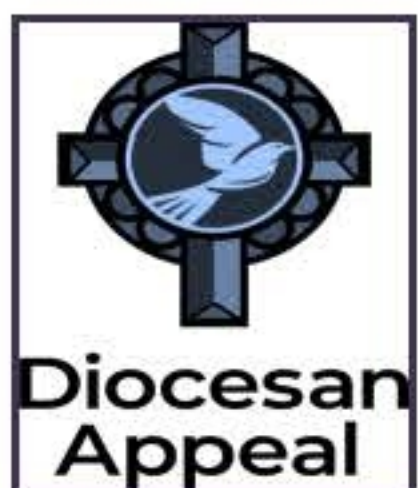

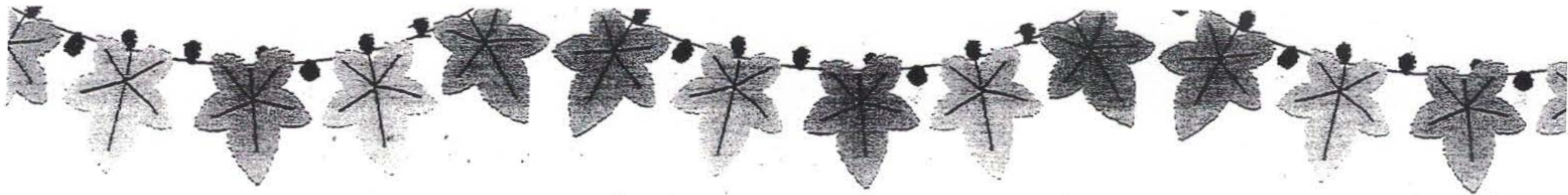
Catholic Singles Night at St. Pius X

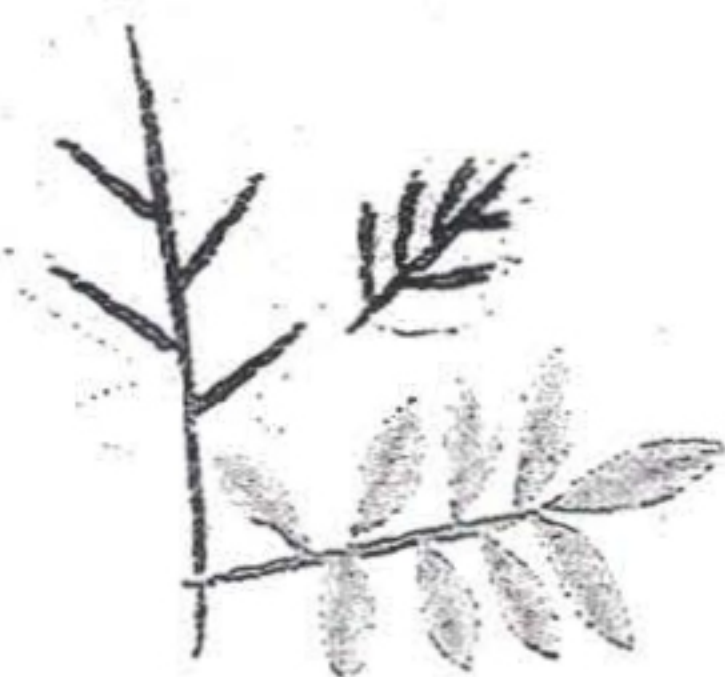
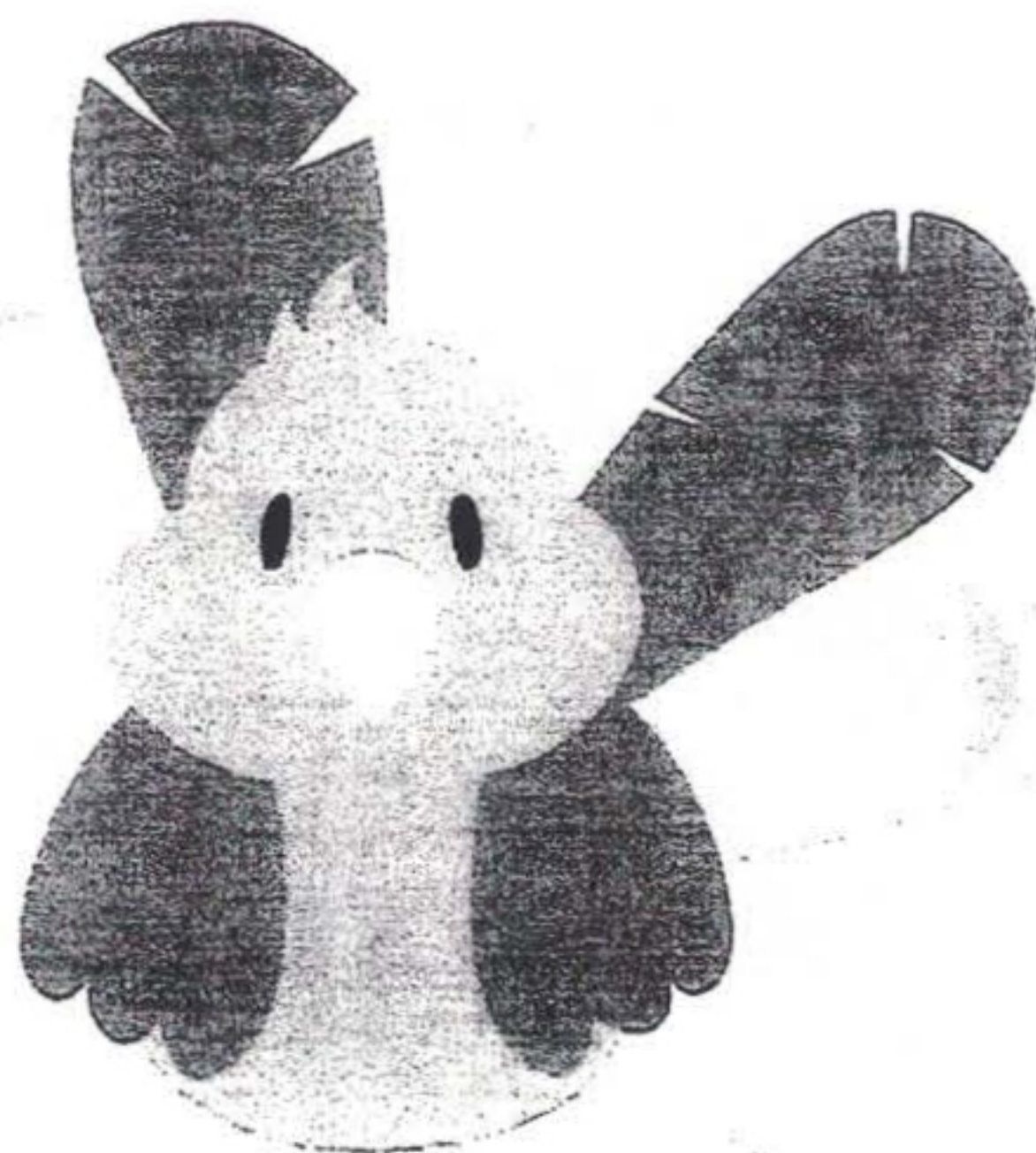
