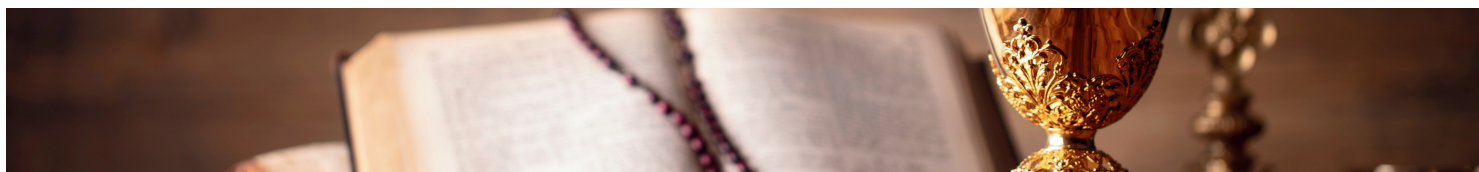

#### What is a Sanctuary Lamp?

A sanctuary lamp is the candle or lamp that burns near the tabernacle, where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved. It is a visible sign of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Each week, parishioners may donate to have the lamp burn in memory of a loved one or for a special intention. This is a prayerful way to entrust someone to the Lord and to keep their memory before Christ, who is our light and our hope.

## WHAT IS AN ENCYCLICAL?

An encyclical is an important letter written by the Pope to help teach, guide, and encourage the Church. The word comes from the idea of a letter being "sent around." In plain English: it is a serious teaching letter from the Pope, usually about something important happening in the Church or the world.

Pope Leo XIV's first encyclical, Magnifica Humanitas, means 'Magnificent Humanity.' It was signed on May 15, 2026, and presented by the Holy See on May 25, 2026. It focuses on safeguarding the human person in the time of artificial intelligence. The Pope is asking important questions:

- How do we make sure technology serves human beings, instead of human beings becoming servants of technology?
- Does this protect human dignity?
- Does this serve the common good?
- Does this help us love God and neighbor?
- Does this make us more human, more truthful, more just, and more faithful?
