Our goal is to challenge, affirm, and encourage youth in their journey toward maturity in their faith. We have two tasks to help us achieve this goal:


- to foster in youth a communal identity as Catholic Christians

Grades K-4 meet on Sunday mornings from 10:00 AM to 10:50 AM (50 minute sessions).

ATTENDANCE POLICY

AT MASS: All Catholics should be attending Sunday Mass every week. Attendance at Mass is a church precept for every Catholic on each weekend and on Holy days.

IN THE CLASSROOM: Attendance is expected at all scheduled classes. If a child is absent on a given week, they will receive a make-up assignment from the catechist which must be completed and returned at the next session.

ABSENCE & MISSED CLASS TIME: Parents are requested to call 283-2163 one hour before the start of class if their child will not be present (leave a message).

CANCELLATIONS: Whenever possible, cancellations will be announced at all Masses and in the Church Bulletin.

BEHAVIOR/DISCIPLINE

Each child is expected to behave in a respectful manner with an attitude of openness to the faith experience. Our teaching staff comes to us as volunteers sharing their own life experiences and richness of the Catholic faith and tradition. Our young people will have the opportunity to learn about our faith and make their own faith journey with a better understanding and appreciation of what this means.

The family is the principle learning center for any child. Our role is to assist the parents in this responsibility. Catechesis, the sharing of faith, takes place every moment of every day, wherever we are and in whatever we do. The Catechists are limited in what they can accomplish in the very short time they have your children during the year. Time spent on discipline issues is time taken away from religious education. We depend upon your support and assistance to maintain a proper learning environment for all.

SAFETY PROCEDURES

GATEKEEPERS: Gatekeepers assist the Coordinators in many ways. Some of their duties include: supervising the hall, escorting late students to class, supervising young children needing to use the bathroom, assisting parents who may be in the building, calling home to verify absences, helping to supervise group dismissal, and other duties as needed.

FIRE DRILLS: At least one evacuation drill for fire emergency will be practiced during the school year.

All Faith Formation access doors will be locked once classes begin.

CURRICULUM

Grades K-6 in our Faith Formation program use a comprehensive curriculum entitled "Blest Are We" which is published by Silver Burdett Ginn. The books in this series focus on sacraments, our liturgical year, feasts, seasons, saints, what Catholics believe as well as prayers we say and much more. Each year provides a foundation for the subsequent years; therefore, attendance at each grade level is strongly recommended.

FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

REGISTRATION

St. Jude Religious Education program must be provided with the following items prior to admission of a child:

- 1. Registration form with Emergency contact information
- 2. The family must be registered in the parish (or provide written permission from parish pastor/administrator acknowledging child in our program)

REGISTRATION FEE

A registration fee is required at enrollment.

\$45 – One Child \$75 – Two or more Children

Notes: Fees are subsidized by the parish, and these fees are for families registered at St. Jude parish and supporting the parish financially. St. Jude Parish is committed to ensuring that all families who wish to send their children to our program are able to do so. Therefore, if for any reason a family has a financial concern as to the registration fee, please speak to me or Father Anthony Ligato.
