ONE-NIGHT ADVENT MISSION DEC 15, 6:30 PM AT ST THOMAS THE APOSTLE

Participants will be guided through five "stations," or familiar scenes from the Infancy Narrative in the Gospels of Luke and Matthew. Each meditation will begin with the reading of a short reflection and Scripture. The focus will shift from spoken reflection to visual and musical reflection: artwork unfolds gradually as music plays. After the heart is opened to the mystery of the Incarnation through meditation, music, and artwork, there will be a seamless transition into an encounter with the True Presence of Christ in Eucharistic Adoration, delicately accompanied by music and periods of silence.
