



ONE MONTH AWAY, SAVE THE DATE: ONE-NIGHT ADVENT MISSION

Sunday, December 15, 6:30-8:00pm in St. Thomas the Apostle Church Free admission, Family-Friendly, "Way of the Star" is a one-night Advent mission experience created to awaken Catholic parishes to the powerful mystery of the Incarnation and to stir the hearts of participants in longing for their Savior. Drawing heavily from the practices of Ignatian imaginative meditation and Lectio Divina, we enter into the familiar scenes of the Infancy Narrative to experience them with fresh minds and hearts: seeing the faces of the Holy Family, hearing their conversations, feeling the cold on the road to Bethlehem, adoring with the shepherd and magi, and encountering the reality of Emmanuel, God with us. Over the course of the program, anchored by original musical compositions, participants journey through Scripture and visual imagery deep into the story of Jesus' birth. It culminates in an encounter with Christ's True Presence during a time of Eucharistic Adoration, accompanied by songs of adoration from The Vigil Project.

The Latin phrase "lectio divina" means "divine reading." It is a venerable method of prayer that involves reading, reflecting on and responding to sacred Scripture.
