Mass for Hope and Healing

Miscarriage is a sensitive subject for women and their families. Studies show up to 4 in 10 women have experienced the death of a preborn child. However, Due to cultural and social factors, many mothers have suffered in silence with the loss of their babies, in some cases for years or decades.

On **Sunday, Nov. 10 at 2pm at St. Joseph's**, our Parish Community of St Joseph's Greenfield Center, St Paul's Rock City Falls, and Holy Mother & Child Corinth will celebrate **a Mass of Hope and Healing** for those who have endured a miscarriage or stillbirth. During the Mass, there will be special prayers for the unborn babies who never had the chance to be born but are mourned by their families. This Mass is open to all and **fulfills the Sunday obligation**.

Your support of our local Food Pantries will allow them to provide the needed healthy nutrition to your friends and neighbors.


