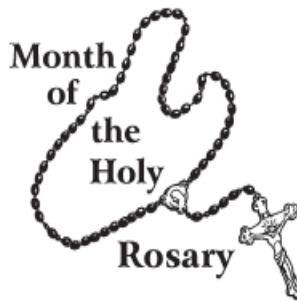

By tradition, the Catholic Church dedicates each month of the year to a certain devotion. The month of October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary, one of the best known of all Catholic devotions. October includes the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (October 7). The best way to celebrate the month is, of course, to pray the Rosary, but these additional prayers can be incorporated into our

daily prayers during this month, too. In order to increase awareness of, and encourage this devotion, we will begin the recitation of the Rosary after the homily at every weekend mass in October, encouraging each of you to finish the rosary later in the day.
