

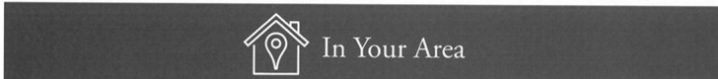

Upcoming Community Program
On **Wednesday, March 26th, at Noon**, Saratoga Phil Di Sorbo, Director of the Senior Life Transitions Program and Barbara Devlin, Volunteer Coordinator for the Saratoga Senior Center, will be at the First United Methodist Church in Corinth. Mr. Di Sorbo is the former Executive Director of Community Hospice and has a career interest in the aging and palliative care. He will be bringing us a PowerPoint presentation about his program, explaining it as a specialized service for seriously ill seniors, which works closely with primary care medical practices to assist in the midst of medically-prompted transitions when they wish to age in place at home. They would like to serve seniors in our area and they use trained volunteers under professional supervision. The volunteers work as part of a team to provide supportive companionship and support services. Ms. Devlin will discuss the vetting process for new volunteers and outline the training program that they are planning to offer later this year in Corinth.
