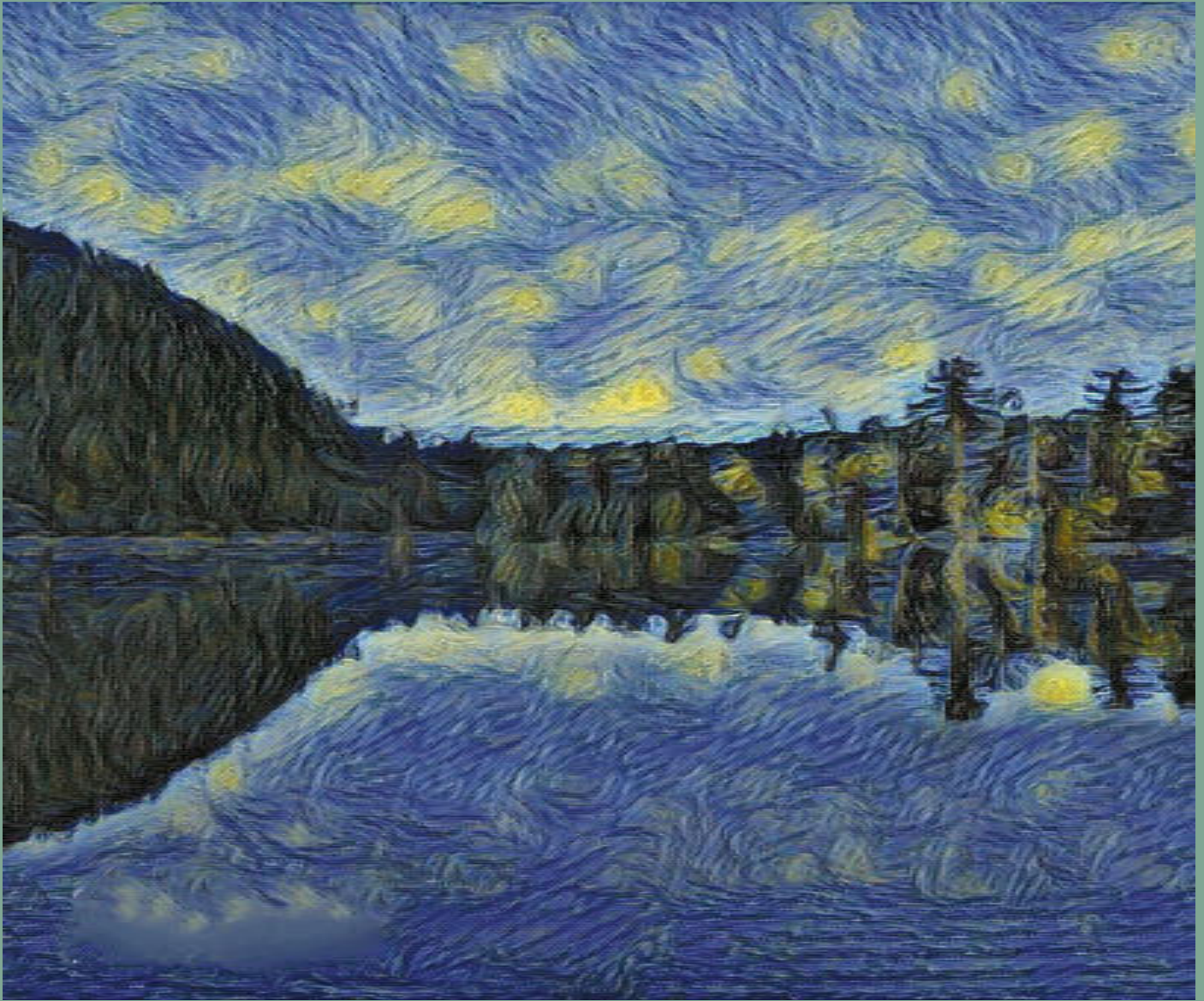

The Hope and Healing Committee of the Diocese of Albany invites you to a powerful and moving event: the performance of "Groomed," a one man play written and performed by Patrick Sandford, a survivor of childhood sexual abuse by his school teacher. This award-winning play has been performed internationally, including at the Vatican, and offers a rare opportunity to witness a survivor's journey from trauma to healing. Patrick's story explores the emotional and psychological effect of abuse and the long, difficult path towards healing. "Groomed" sheds light on the devastating impact of abuse, while also offering hope and healing through its raw and honest portrayal.

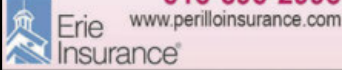
