**The resurrection of the Lord
Alleluia, Alleluia, Christ is Risen!**

A happy and blessed Easter to all of you! Christ, the Victor, has conquered the power of death and brought us the gift of new life. This is a great mystery and an amazing truth which we celebrate and witness to it in our lives. I thank all of you for your presence here today and for your participation in this joyous and solemn celebration. I am particularly grateful to all of our liturgical ministers including our music directors, cantors, lectors, Eucharistic ministers, altar servers, ushers, and our decorating team. All of you inspire me and many others by your total commitment and loving service to our parish family. I pray that the wonder of the resurrection may ignite your Christian faith and deepen your relationship with God and His church. Thank you so much, and may God's blessing be abundant upon you, your family, and all loved ones!

As Christians, Easter continues to be a living reality that transforms our lives. The Easter season is a time to move from the pain of grief to joy and despair to hope. In the scriptures we see how the power of Christ's resurrection chased the darkness of fear, grief, and despair away and filled the hearts of the disciples and other followers with the light of hope and joy.

After the death and burial of Jesus, everything seemed lost for the disciples and the women who accompanied and supported the Lord in His ministry. They never expected to see Jesus again. In a wonderful way, the dawning of the first Easter morning changed everything. The good news of the resurrection brought joy and new strength to the disciples and the women.

All the gospel writers credit Mary Magdalene as the first person who witnessed the Lord's resurrection. The love that Mary Magdalene had for Jesus put her into such wonderful experience.

The gospel of John recounts that on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the burial place of Jesus and she found an empty tomb. She concluded what made perfect sense: "They have taken the Lord from the tomb". She ran to announce the shocking yet joyful news to Peter and John, the disciple whom Jesus loved. These two disciples hurried to the burial place of Jesus, and they witnessed everything as reported to them. Here was the beginning of their journey to Easter faith. Peter and John did not yet understand the scripture message. Later, Jesus appeared to the disciples to prove His living presence among them. He called the disciples and all of us to move away from the tombs of despair and fear toward hope and new life. St. Paul reminds us in the second reading that as people buried and raised with Christ, we should seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Saint Paul exhorts all of us to set our minds on heavenly things rather than on earthly things.

You and I need to remember that in Christ, we are offered new life and a new beginning. As we renew our baptismal promises this Easter, let us do so with great faith and eagerness to bury our old selves and rise with Christ to newness of life. Like Mary Magdalene, and the disciples, let us bear witness to the resurrection news by reaching out in love and compassion to those around us. Let us help others to know hope and joy in their lives through our kind words and loving deeds.
