

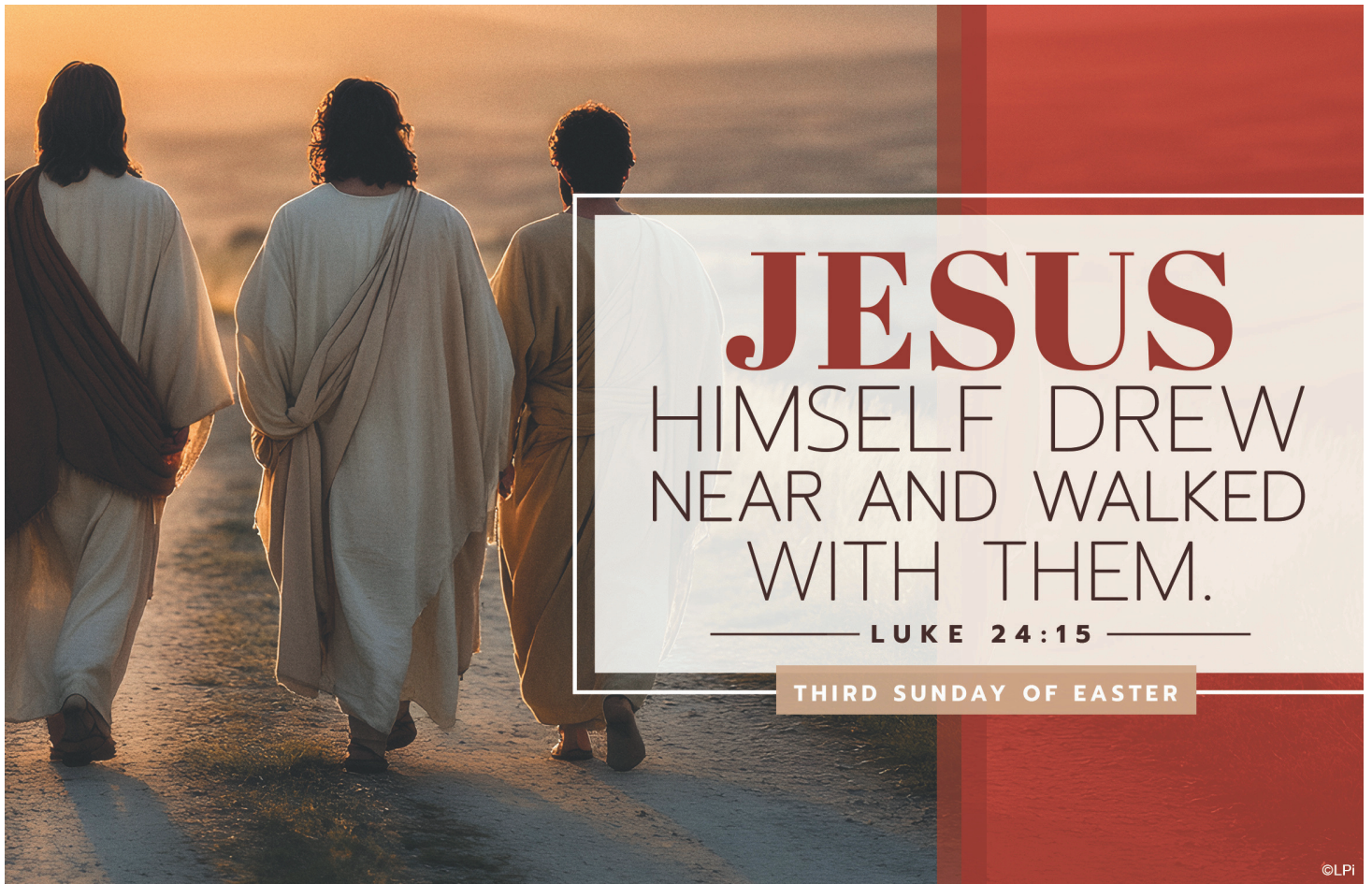

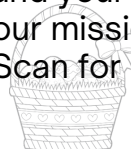
Spring Book Club

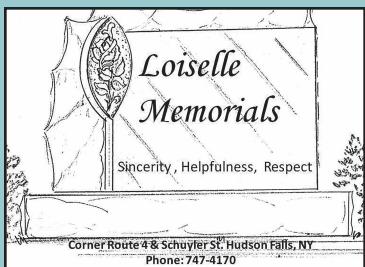
