IMMIGRATION – Refugee Update August 9 - 10, 2025

An Endless Thank You!

As announced earlier, we will now shift to collecting goods that can be used as Refugees set up housekeeping. In the pews you will find a "HOME SET-UP CHECKLIST" that they use. Please review this for any items you may have at home, that can be donated. Of course, we will accept new items but the intent is to look at lightly used "duplicates" or items that we no longer use. Its sometimes surprising to see how much we have that is simply "extra".

We have set **AUGUST 2-3**, and **AUGUST 9-10** as collection weekends here at Church for us to bring these items in. You can place them in the **LAST PEWS ACROSS THE BACK OF CHURCH** and we will take it from there to get them delivered. We chose the back pews to avoid using the hall/unlocking/monitoring etc.

IMMIGRATION FACT: Almost 9 in 10 U.S. adults, 85%, favor a pathway to citizenship for immigrants brought here illegally as children that increased support for pathways to citizenship largely comes from Republicans, about 6 in 10 of whom now support that, up from 46% last year." (Gallup Poll).

IMMIGRATION Refugee Update Cont....

The U. S. Committee for Refugees (USCRI) and Immigrants is located on the First floor of 155 Washington Avenue, Albany, NY 12210.

USCRI was established in 1911, and; is a *nongovernmental, Not-for-Profit* **International Organization** dedicated to helping refugees and immigrants.

The Albany Office was established in 2005 and has settled more than 6,000 refugees in the Capital Region, most of whom had to leave their home countries. Their current caseload is @ 450 families.

They work with RISSE, whom we also supported when we first started this, but RISSE does not handle household goods, materials, etc.
