## IMMIGRATION – Refugee Update July 5-6, 2025

### *A BIG THANKS!!! TO ALL WHO DONATED FOR THE ROHINGYA FAMILIES.*

I delivered \$1276.00 to Shannon at US CRI this past week!!! They are VERY thankful as this will help defray their rent and give them more time to get on their feet.

I also took in THREE more strollers from the United Methodist Church, another sewing machine, an air conditioner, and another load of totes! I asked what is status of sewing machine needs and they said with our donations and another big donation they have dropped the need from 40 to 20 strollers!! They only need couple of the doubles now but said that extras are good thing as they have 3 pregnant moms.

Also, FYI, CRI oversees care for over 450 refugee families in our area!!! Needs fluctuate as they do for all of us. I expect as seasons change, school starts up etc. there will be different needs. I will be monitoring this with CRI to keep us informed.

**Immigration Fact:** Asylum is ONE category refugees may qualify for. It is one of the hardest.

- Our administration has to APPROVE that they are eligible based on their country being currently at war, etc. Once the situation (in that country) has improved, they are then sent back home.
- Currently we have Ukrainians, Haitians and Venezuelans, of which our administration now says the last two groups CAN BE SENT BACK HOME.
- Changing from the Asylum category is also extremely difficult to get approved.

Please ask yourself if YOU would be willing to go back to those countries.

Again, you all have taken a big step to help our fellow travelers on this road of life.
