IMMIGRATION – Refugee Update July 19-20, 2025

First, another thank you for the donations of \$135 and also, a gift card this past week. That went into the CRI office.

Secondly, as announced earlier, we will now shift to Collecting Goods that can be used as Refugees set up housekeeping. In the Pews you will find a HOME SET-UP CHECKLIST that they use. Please review this for any items you may have at home, that can be donated. Of course, we will accept new items but the intent is to look at lightly used "duplicates" or items that we no longer use. Its sometimes surprising to see how much we have that is simply "extra".

We have set AUGUST 2-3, and AUGUST 9-10 as collection weekends here at Church for us to bring these items in. You can place them in the LAST PEWS ACROSS THE BACK OF CHURCH and we will take it from there to get them delivered.

IMMIGRATION FACT: The most recent Gallup Poll on Immigration has indicated that: about 8 in 10 Americans (79%), say immigration is "a good thing" for the country today; an increase from 64% a year ago and, a high point in the nearly 25-year trend.

Only about 2 in 10 U S Adults say immigration is a bad thing right now; down from 32% last year. (Times Union, July 13, 2025)
