

Why do we go to church? Why attend Mass? Is it to fulfill an obligation mandated by the Church or to make us feel good for various reasons? If those things work out then that is an advantage but our reason for going isn't for our benefit, though often that happens. Our reason is for God's benefit; to give thanks and praise to the One who has given us everything we have and are. He has given us life and skills to use for his praise and benefit. Sure, we may put in the effort but even that comes from God so it should only make sense that we thank and praise Him for that.

I've heard many times that someone didn't like the priest/deacon or the homily. We usually put a lot of time, research and effort into our homilies. I know I pray that the Holy Spirit let my words touch the people or person God wants to hear them in the manner chosen by Him. That doesn't mean everyone will enjoy it or "get it". Though we hope to reach everyone in some way we don't always succeed. Some of us are better than others because of different gifts. Most Masses last less than an hour and we get upset if it goes longer. I have had tendencies to complain about that myself. Yet if we are there for God's benefit and not ours it shouldn't matter if it does. It's that much more time we are spending with our Lord. Sure, we have other events scheduled but we need to always put God first. Maybe even schedule other things later just in case Mass runs longer.

We aren't always going to leave Mass saying that was an amazing experience but if we leave knowing we have been there for God's sake because we love Him we will please Him more than we could ever say.
