Anointing of the Sick


Can be administered at any stage of a person's illness. If possible, one should not wait until someone is near death before requesting anointing. To schedule please call Parish Office 315-866-6373.





Reminders from the Cemetery Staff

Our Calvary Cemetery is now open and with that in mind, please know that we are very grateful for the efforts our cemetery families make to decorate and beautify their family plots with

lovely flowers, greenery (and even vegetables). Just a reminder that plantings cannot extend more than 12 inches in front of the stone markers or be situated so that cemetery lawn mowers are impeded in their work. NO decorations are permitted BEHIND cemetery stones because those gravesites belong to others. Artifical flowers can be placed over the stone but not planted in the ground and No plastic, glass or anything else deemed UNSAFE for cemetery personal to do their jobs will be allowed or these things will be removed. Thank you!

* PLEASE: Our cemetery workers have a great deal of work to do in order to make sure graves are opened and burials proceed with respect to families who have just lost their loved ones. They also need to mow, weed whack etc. Please respect them when they ask you to move yourself or your car out of their way. They need to complete their job without anyone getting hurt. Again, thank you.



Please remember you can put your envelopes into the collection basket at any of the churches and they will be delivered to the church marked on the front of the envelope. Also, if you

don't have envelopes and would like to put cash into the collection basket for a specific church, please use an envelope and put the name of the church on the front of the envelope. There are envelopes in the vestibule of the churches.
