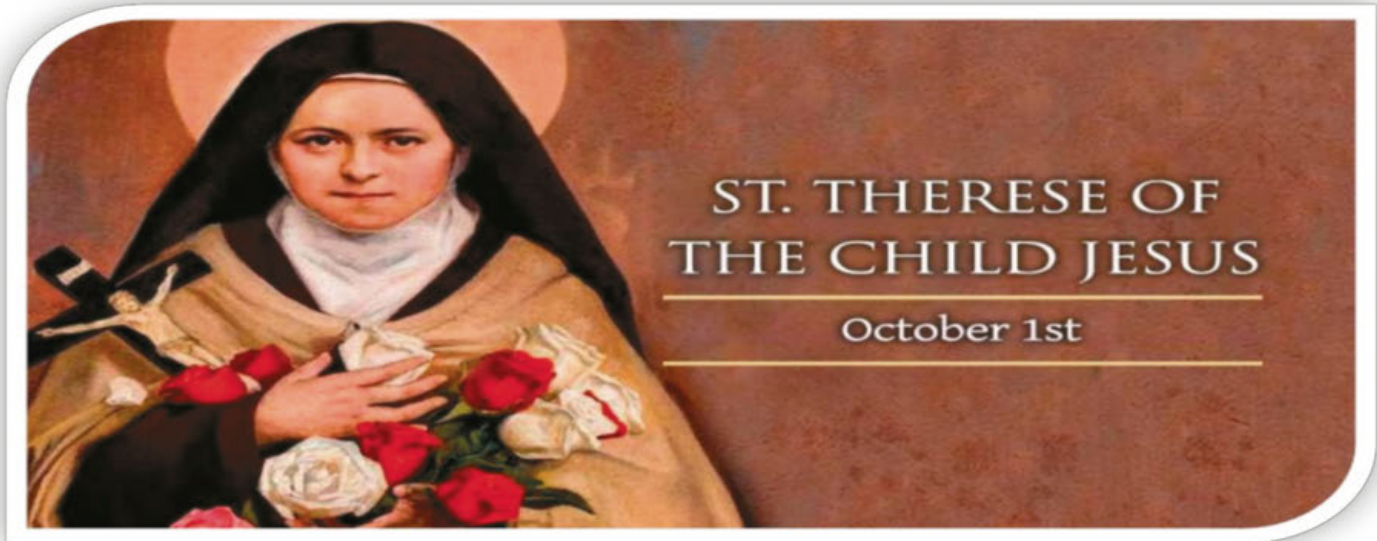

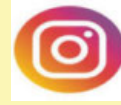

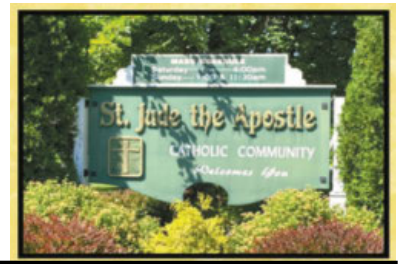

Twenty Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings this week encourage us to think about our humility before God. Sometimes we become complacent about our commitment to our faith. We can begin to fall away from the practice of our faith and think we don't really need to participate in Mass or take an active part in the mission of the Church.

If we recall what the Church teaches us about our baptism, we come to realize that the expectation of every Christian is lifelong participation in the mission of the Church. We share in the Kingdom of Christ, and we also share in His mission. We receive great dignity in becoming children of God through our baptism, yet we also receive great responsibility. Sometimes we can be a lot like the servants who say we will go into the vineyard, but we never really do. If we truly humble ourselves before God and realize our constant need for Christ, then we will want to participate fully in the life of the church. We will recognize the grace that we can receive through regular reception of the sacraments and through frequent dialogue with Christ in prayer. We become like the servant who realizes the error of refusing God's grace through sin and we constantly turn back to Him. After growing strong in our own commitment to Christ, we then happily serve Him by bringing the Good News to others of the Grace we have received from Jesus.

This year St. Jude the Apostle School expanded its partnership with the Averill Park School District for their Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) program to include three classrooms, educating 47 students. Universal Pre-Kindergarten is a government funded program that makes pre-k education available to families on a lottery system. Public Districts, such as Averill Park, apply for the funding and families apply for the program through the public district. Averill Park is housing their UPK classrooms at St. Jude the Apostle School, and pays St. Jude a set fee for each student, because they do not have the room to house the program within their district buildings. It is an excellent partnership and both ends have seen a benefit from the program since its first year. This year's lead teachers are Mrs. Martuscello (Miss Molitor – TA), Mrs. Werger (Mrs. Agy – TA), and Mrs. Brammer (Mrs. Dearborn – TA). All three teachers were excited to welcome their students on September 7th.

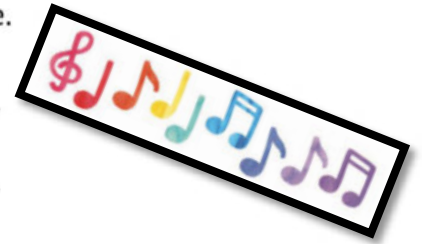


