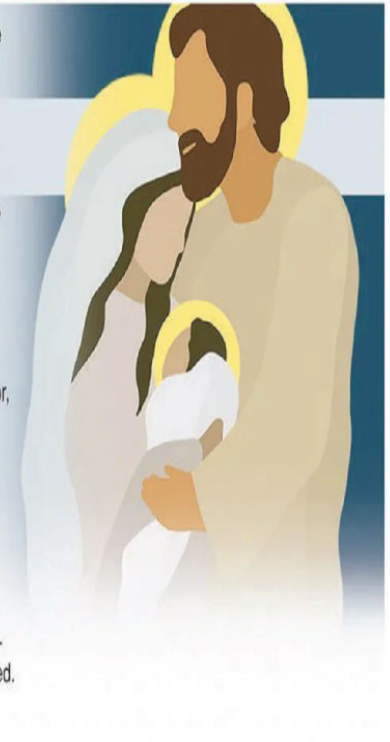
A Prayer to St. Joseph, Defender of Life
