Throughout Derek's life he excelled with academics and his lifelong medical challenge. During Derek's life he accepted and overcame several physical and emotional challenges. Q: Why do we fast before mass?

A: Fasting physically prepares ourselves to receive the Eucharist (Holy Communion) by creating a sense of spiritual hunger and reverence for the sacredness of Jesus Christ's body and blood, signifying that this is the most important nourishment received, above any physical food; essentially, it's a way to demonstrate deep respect and focus before partaking in the sacrament.
