Protein is necessary for the proper functioning of body cells. Proteins are amino acids which 9 out of 20 amino acids comes from food. Most adults should get 10-35% of their daily calories from protein-men need 56 grams per day, women-46 grams. Meat, dairy, seafood, eggs, nuts, legumes and soy all contain protein. Protein deficiency can cause a decrease in muscle mass, fatigue, changes in hair texture and difficulty healing wounds. Protein intake makes us feel full, so they are helpful for those who are trying to lose weight-protein has less calories than carbohydrates.
