

Please use the tags that are in the Easter Basket in the gathering area.

Teething rings, sippy cups, bibs, infant crackers, books, shampoo, coloring books, crayons, coloring pencils, facial tissues, toothpaste and toothbrushes, dental floss, hairbrushes/combs, hair bands/clips, small stuffed animals, bubbles, reading books, toys, puzzles and traditional candy or snacks.

Please bring your baskets to St. Michael's Church no later than Sunday, April 13th. Baskets will be delivered to Circles of Mercy where they will be distributed to families in our local communities before Easter.

Your support and generosity is greatly appreciated. The baskets will delight the children and make their Easter celebration special.
