

Isn't it reassuring and gratifying that Jesus takes this post-resurrection moment to bless you and to bless me?



WHAT IS DIVINE MERCY MESSAGE AND DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY?

Jesus appeared to a Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kuolska in Poland during WWII. She wrote about these revelations in her Diary, *Divine Mercy in My Soul*. The Message of Divine Mercy is simple--Ask for God's Mercy, practice merciful love to our neighbor in Deed, Word, and Prayer (Diary 742), and to have Complete Trust in God's unconditional Love and Mercy for us. This message is not anything new but a great reminder to us of God's great command to "love your neighbor as yourself" and to "Be merciful as your heavenly Father is merciful." (Luke 6:36) In a world where we are weighed down by daily trials, fears, physical and emotional suffering, worry, anxiety, economic uncertainty---The Divine Mercy Message challenges us to REPLACE our FEAR with FAITH and live the words JESUS I TRUST IN YOU!
