

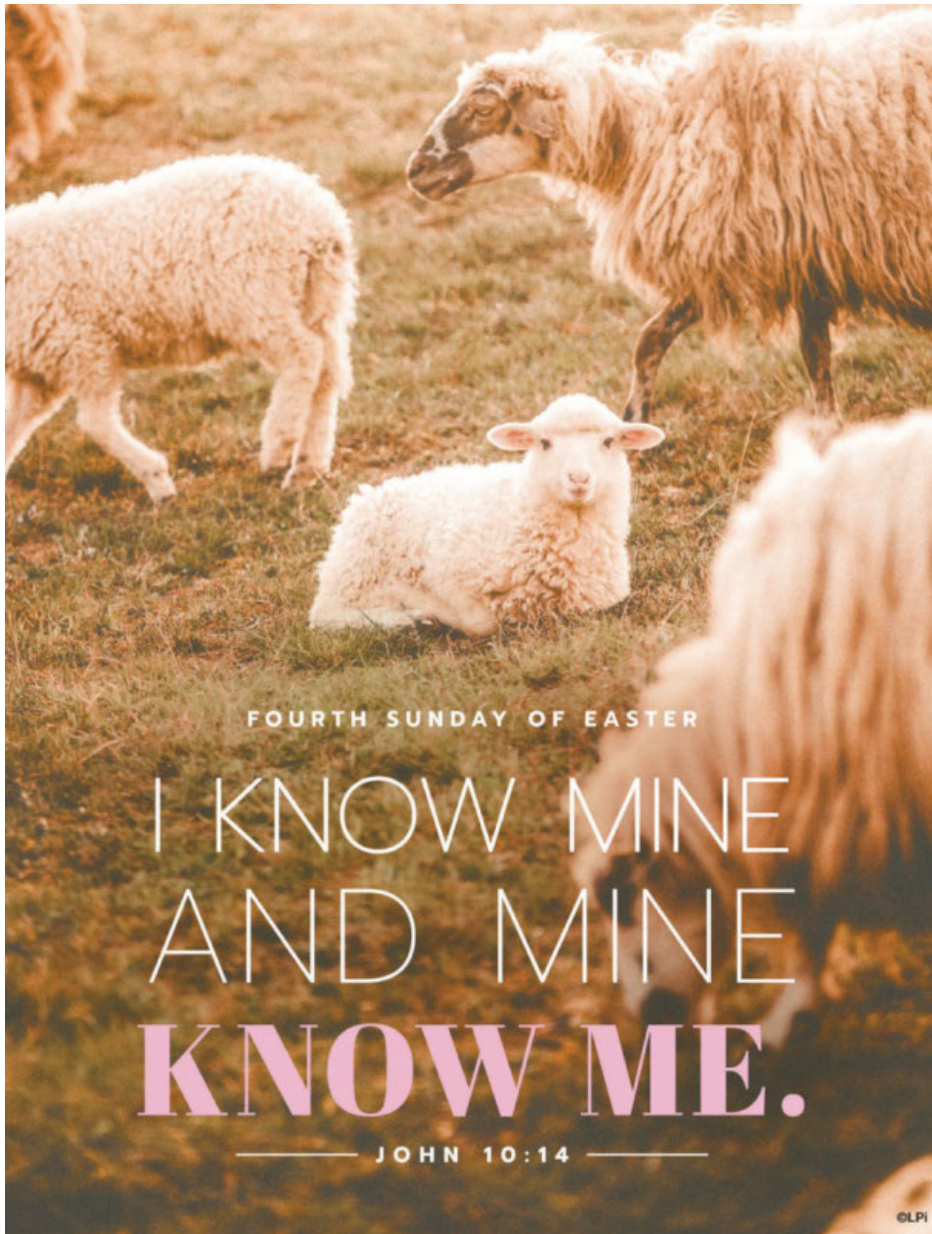

DOES THE DIOCESAN BUDGET GET CUT? DIOCESAN APPEAL -- 2023-24, UPDATED APRIL 15

Yes, each year there have been significant cuts made to the Diocesan budget as a reflection of revenue. As one example, since 2020 more than 22 positions have been eliminated through attrition or retirement & will not be replaced, resulting in a reduction in staffing of 28%. Unfortunately, this also yields a reduction and/or possible delay in services and initiatives.

Christ the King's assessment for this year is \$128,327. To date we have received \$54,625, from a total of 126 in pledges and outright gifts. We thank you for your generous support!
