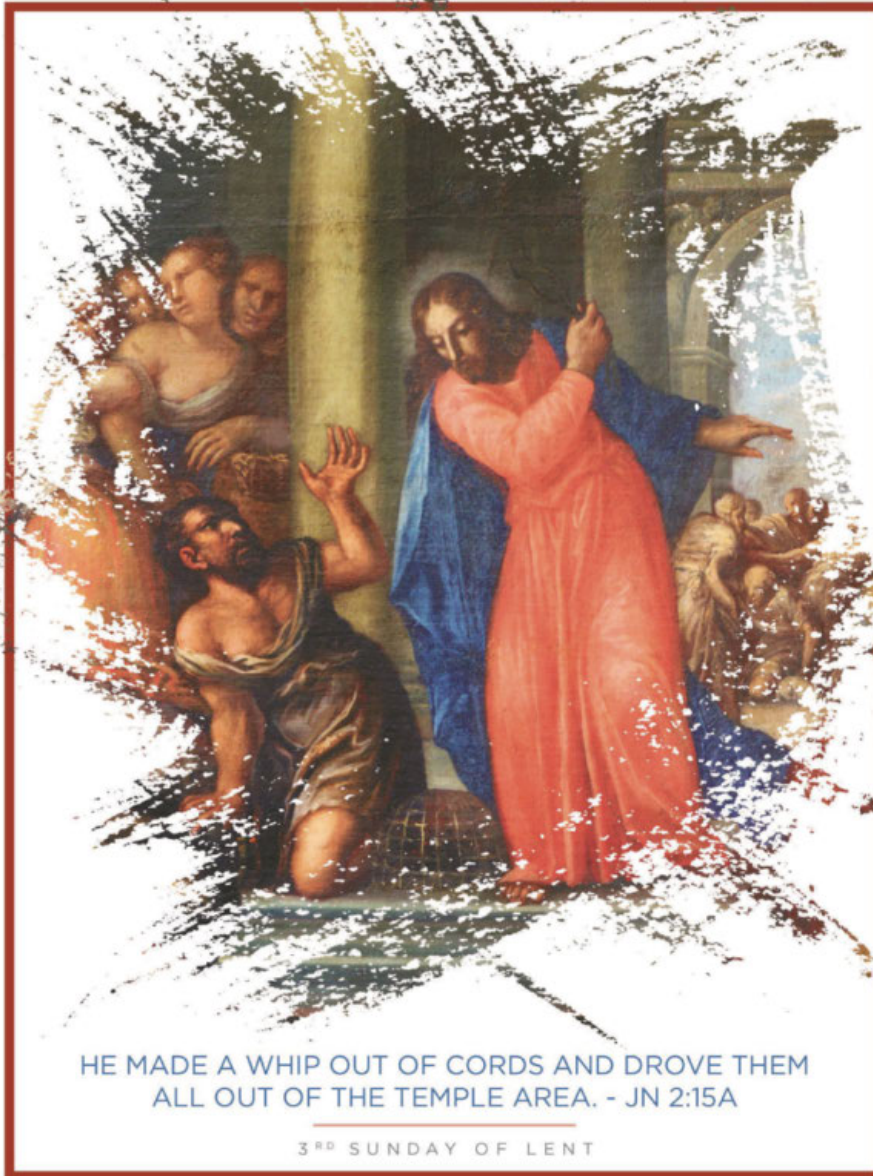

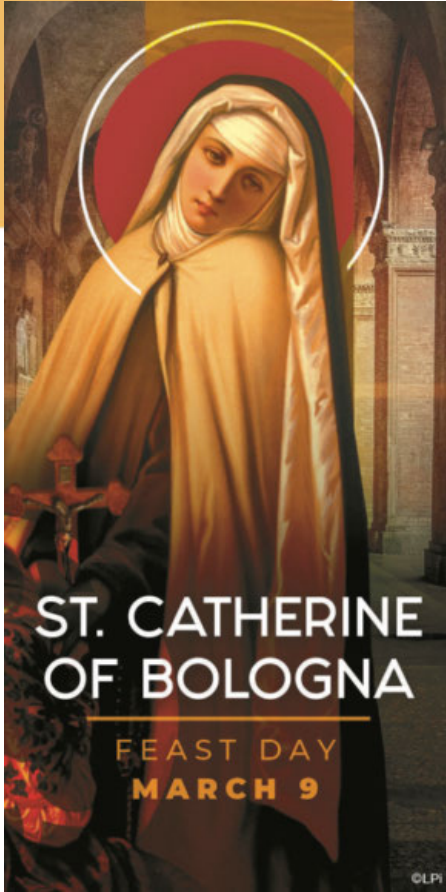

LENT AT CTK

SAINT JOSEPH'S TABLE

Saint Joseph is one of the most beloved saints among Italian-Americans. As the patron of workers and the protector of the family, he is honored with a feast on March 19. According to legend, there was a famine in Sicily many centuries ago. The villagers prayed to St. Joseph, foster-father of the Infant Savior, and asked his intercession before the throne of God. Their prayers were answered. With the ending of the dreadful famine, a special feast of thanksgiving was held in commemoration of the Saint. This celebration became tradition. Wealthy families prepared huge buffets. They then invited the less fortunate people of the village, especially the homeless and sick. Here at Christ the King this year, we ask each parishioner to bring a food item and place it on the tables in the Gathering Space the weekend of March 16-17. All the food collected will be blessed after the 10:30 Mass on March 20th and then will be distributed to the Guilderland food pantry and to Saint John's/ St. Anne's food pantry in the intercity of Albany. This is a wonderful way for each member of our parish (children too) to give Alms to those in need during this Lenten Season. Let's fill the Gathering Space with food!

COFFEE AND CONVERSATION

On Thursday, March 14, at 6 pm, Father Gary Gelfenbien will present "The Sound and Light of Lent- The Art and Architecture of Renewal". The concentration of this presentation is the emphasis on the Lenten themes of the Scriptural stories of Abraham and Isaac, Christ as the new Adam, the Transfiguration as Metamorphosis. The expressions of sculpture, Eastern mosaic, stained glass and painting highlight the familiar aspects of Lenten texts and bring to life the transcendent elements of these touching stories. 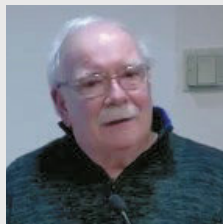
