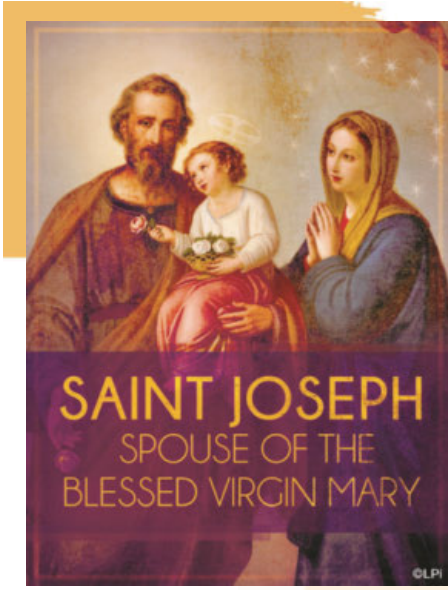

ST. PATRICK AND ST. JOSEPH

CTK Family Life Ministry is helping us to celebrate the feast days of two great saints—St. Patrick (March 17) and St. Joseph (March 19) by providing prayer cards of both saints in gathering space for all to learn about the saints and ask for their intercession.

SAINT JOSEPH'S TABLE

As the patron of workers and the protector of the family, Saint Joseph is honored with a feast on March 19. Here at CTK this year, we ask each parishioner to bring a food item and place it on the tables in the Gathering Space the weekend of March 16-17. All the food collected will be blessed after the 10:30 Mass on March 20th and then will be distributed to the Guilderland food pantry and to Saint John's/ St. Anne's food pantry. This is a wonderful way for each member of our parish (children too) to give Alms to those in need during this Lenten Season.

EASTER FIRE WATCHERS

Fire is one of the most frequently used symbols in our faith with a number of different meanings; the Holy Spirit, purification, or the light of Christ who brings us out of the darkness with His resurrection.

Each year, CTK lights our Easter fire at the conclusion of our Holy Thursday service and keeps it burning until the start of the Easter Vigil. Did you know?

Whether you know him as the man who brought Christianity to Ireland or simply as a reason you eat corned beef and cabbage in March, St. Patrick (415 – 493) is a well-known saint around the world.

St. Patrick was born in Britain of a Romanized family. At the age of 16, he was kidnapped by Irish raiders from the villa of his father, a deacon and local official, and brought into slavery in Ireland. He spent six long years there as a herdsman, during which he turned to his faith for strength. He later escaped back to Britain on a ship, where he was eventually reunited with his family.

His years of captivity changed him and brought out a zeal for God and a yearning to spread the message of Jesus Christ. Despite the constant danger of martyrdom, he continued to travel throughout Ireland where he baptized and confirmed in the name of Christ.

CTK SENIOR CIRCLE

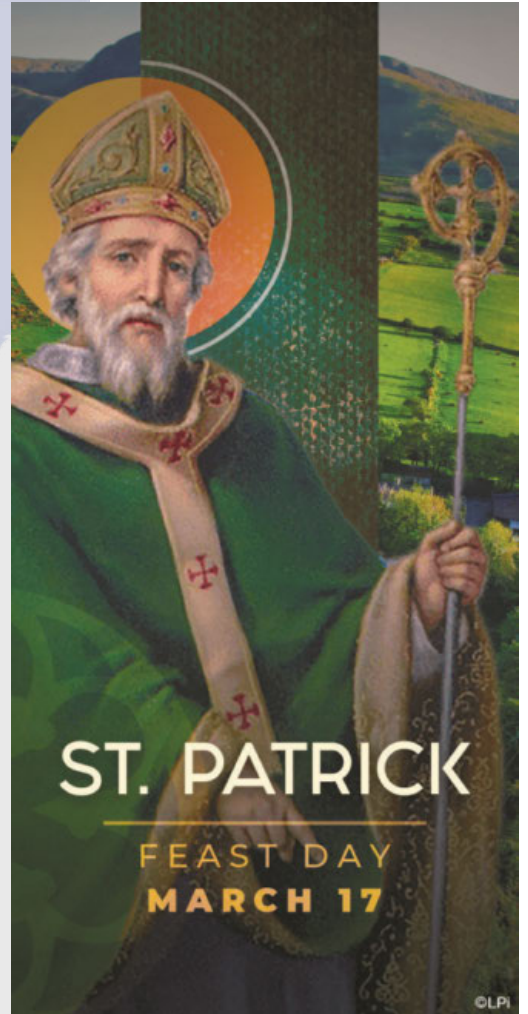
