• <u>Advertising</u>

Kerry missed Pennysaver deadline for this Tuesday (3/5), will get in for next week. Kerry will look at sandwich board to get posterboard for putting up next week; need large print.

Matthew will work on putting something on church signboard (we need new letters for the board!).

Marguerite will talk to Lois Jones about getting advertising on Firehouse sign.

Flyer went to the Morris Area Christian Churches. Penny Harrington has already printed and posted.

• <u>Supplies</u>

Ask for people to donate desserts. Drop off downstairs during week of March 10; put in fridge if fresh-baked.

We will use cutlery from downstairs and Marguerite's.

We will buy batter (for fish), oilbutter, salt/pepper, ketchup, lemon, coffee, milk, sugar, plates, cups, tablecloths, dish detergent, dish cloths (wash and dry), gloves for serving. [broccoli coleslaw: 4 12 oz. bags (48 ounces total), Napa cabbage: 3 head (48 ounces shredded), 4 20 oz. cans of unsweetened pineapple (80 ounces), 2 bunches scallions, 2 containers mayonnaise (four cups) – for coleslaw]

Marguerite can provide sheet pans for keeping fish warm.

Marguerite will take care of tartar sauce.

Kerry and Jen will coordinate coleslaw. - Kerry makes for 20; Jen for 30

Matthew will make iced tea.

Kerry will donate napkins.

Matthew will take inventory this week and determine what we need to purchase. He will pick up fish and potatoes, etc. [Maine's of Binghamton]

Matthew will email the group for what we need.

Jen and Kerry will bring a crock pot; Kerry will bring water bath canner for potatoes.

**Coffee needs to be put on an hour to 90 minutes ahead of time.

Anonymous donor for expenses = \$350.00; don't have a set budget. Quick check in after mass next Sunday.

- 2. Contacting those who did not complete a survey

Have sign in list for meal; have surveys available along with jar for free will donations. Proceeds from meal: put back into church (to reimburse for expenses), donate to Caring Connections division of Catholic Charities – Kerry will contact for a brochure, information to have to introduce people.

<u>Financials</u>

\$19,000 in bank

- We owe diocese for second collections [sending for second collections plus what we should have sent; about \$1500 left to pay off].
- Diocesan appeal is separate from weekly collections. This year goal = \$5,000. (Formula that looks at parish collections to see what we can afford to give.) Appeal starts July 1 and ends June 30 of following year. [New rule: Minimum for parish = \$5,000]
