### **Diocesan Confirmation Guidelines and or local Parish Policies**

- Candidate must be baptized
- Candidate is minimally in Grade 10 or 15 years of age
- If a youth, candidate is practicing in the parish's faith formation program at least one year prior to the immediate preparation for Confirmation
- Candidate participates fully in the immediate preparation for Confirmation
- Candidate shows a sincere desire to live his/her faith as a disciple of Jesus with the Catholic community
- Candidate has a sponsor who meets the requirements for Confirmation

# Additional Diocesan Guidelines and our local Parish Policies

- Candidate must attend all preparation sessions
- Candidate must participate in a parish approved Confirmation retreat
- Candidate must participate in community service an apprenticeship for their role as a Catholic adult
- Candidate may have a final interview with the Pastor, Confirmation Coordinator or Parish Life Director
