#### This weekend we welcome...

Fr. Ron Sadjak, our annual Mission Cooperative Appeal guest, representing Masaka Missionaries Diocesan Medical Services.

The Medical Services Ministry coordinates and supplies thirty-seven medical clinics and two hospitals. The Catholic Church leads the way in offering HIV prevention, care of Orphan and Vulnerable Children, maternal and childcare services as well as clean water, sanitation, and nutrition programs.

From this year's cooperative plan, the Diocese is seeking financial support to extend their warehouse for storing medicines. The medical store was started with support from the Buffalo based: Reaching out 2 Africa Organization after realizing that there were many counterfeit medical supplies on the Uganda market. The main objective of this store was to ensure the availability of safe and affordable medicines in the Diocese and to save the lives of people from potentially dangerous products. After 10 years in operation, the existing warehouse needs to be expanded to accommodate the ever-increasing range of products needed to satisfy the health needs of the people in the area.

We hope and pray that you will join with us as the Catholic Church continues to be the source of hope and healing for so many poor around the world especially in the Diocese of Masaka, Uganda
