Mass for Hope and Healing

Miscarriage is a sensitive subject for women and their families. Studies show up to 4 in 10 women have experienced the death of a preborn child. However, Due to cultural and social factors, many mothers have suffered in silence with the loss of their babies, in some cases for years or decades.

On *Sunday, November 10 at 2pm, our Parish Community of St Joseph's Greenfield Center, St Paul's Rock City Falls, and Holy Mother & Child Corinth* will be holding a *Mass for Hope and Healing* for those who have endured a miscarriage or stillbirth. During the Mass, there will be special prayers for the unborn babies who never had the chance to be born but are mourned by their families. This Mass is open to all and *fulfills the Sunday obligation.*

Why World Mission Sunday Matters

World Mission Sunday, observed on October 20th this year, is not just another Sunday, it is a powerful reminder of our call to be missionaries. The collection taken up on this day is unique as it is mandated by the Code of Canon Law and is essential for the survival and growth of the Church in mission territories. These funds support the pastoral and evangelizing work of the Church, including building churches, providing healthcare and education, and training future priests and religious. In places where

 Mass at 12:30 with a Reception to follow.



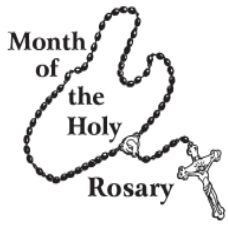

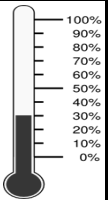
