

We Pray Ordinary Time

Our worship space and liturgies are simpler (compared to the exuberance of Easter and wonder of Christmas), yet noble in their own beauty. Our Glory to God is the Taizé mantra "Gloria in excelsis Deo, Alleluia!". The response to the Hebrew Scripture is Psalm 118: "Whose love is forever, whose love is forever more". Our Gospel acclamation is a joyful "Alle, Alle, Alleluia!" In our gathering at the Lord's Table we sing the Mass of Mother Cabrini, music in honor of this immigrant woman who served so many newcomers to our land. In Faith, we sing "When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we prodaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again." We witness to God's eternal love, even in the midst of the world's Cross. As we break the Bread, we chant "Lamb of God, miserere nobis; Dona nobis pacem" (have mercy on us and grant us peace). We, though many, are from and of the One Body of Christ.
