We Sing Winter Ordinary Time

In these weeks between Christmas and Ash Wednesday (and the beginning of Lent) our liturgies are simpler; our worship space centers around the people, pulpit, and Table of the Lord. Our Glory to God is the Taizé “Gloria in excelsis Deo, Alleluia!”. The response to the Hebrew Scripture is Psalm 113: *Praised be the name of the Lord.* We sing of our God who transcends the earth and skies, yet cares intimately for each and every person. We stand during the Celtic Alleluia as the Gospel is proclaimed. When we gather around the Table and celebrate Christ in our midst we sing of our mystery: “When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup we proclaim your Death....” The Lord compels us to enter into the Cross of our world with new-found faith in the power of God’s Love. Change Our World


