

Our Lady of Fatima

May 13th, 2025



For Catholics, Mother's Day and Our Lady of Fatima are interconnected, both celebrating the role of motherhood. Mother's Day is a secular celebration, while Our Lady of Fatima is a Marian devotion stemming from apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Both offer a unique perspective on the importance of motherhood, with Mary at Fatima being seen as a model of maternal love and intercession.

Mother's Day and Mary's Maternal Role:

The National Catholic Register notes that Mother's Day is an opportunity to honor both natural mothers and Mary, The Mother of God, as the perfect model of motherhood. Mary's willingness to say "yes" to God's calling, as seen in her role as the mother of Jesus, is a powerful example for all mothers.

Our Lady of Fatima:

In the village of Fatima, Portugal, in 1917, the Virgin Mary allegedly appeared to three shepherd children, Lucia, Jacinta, and Francisco. These apparitions are seen as a confirmation of the authenticity of the Virgin Mary's role as a guide and intercessor, particularly for those seeking peace and salvation.

Fatima's Message and Intercession:

The message of Our Lady of Fatima emphasizes the importance of prayer, particularly the rosary, and devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It also highlights the importance of conversion and a return to God. The Divine Mercy notes that Mary intercedes for us before her Son, Jesus, offering solace and support in times of need.

Mary as a Model of Motherhood:

Catholic Exchange points out that Mary's maternal love and the message of Fatima are closely linked. The Feast of Our Lady of Fatima, observed on May 13th, is seen as a way to honor Mary and her motherly guidance, making every day a Mother's Day for her.


