

PASTORAL REFLECTION (DECEMBER 7, SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT)

John the Baptist said: "The one who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." (Matthew 3:10-11)

During the season of Advent, we hear fiery words from John the Baptist. The first two weeks of Advent focus on the final coming of the Lord in regal glory. This reminds us that there is more to the "the first coming" of the Lord in the baby Jesus, which we celebrate at Christmas.

For many people Christmas is a difficult time. It may be the first Christmas without a loved one who recently died or a time of struggle. That is why the second and final coming of Christ gives true hope—



that the Lord offers us His constant companionship and grace if we accept His merciful love.

If there's one family who should not have had to suffer, it should have been the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, yet they were hunted by Herod's soldiers who desired to kill the newborn son of Mary, the unrecognized Son of God. Nevertheless, the little Lord Jesus was born in safety and heavenly peace, adored by shepherds, angels, and wise men, while His Blessed Virgin Mother pondered all these things in her Immaculate Heart. As we enter Advent's second week, may we accept Jesus's gift to us of His Mother, Mary the Immaculate Conception, whose pure faith and motherly prayers to her Son can obtain for us a deeper desire to accept His call to holiness, that the Lord may find a welcome home in our hearts and prepare us for His coming—His Advent.


