
Welcome! - Bienvenido! - Mabuhay!

Did you know our Cathedral is home to a spectacular monstrance nearly five feet tall? This striking receptacle is designed to hold the consecrated Eucharistic Host, the Body of Christ, for adoration and veneration of Our Lord outside of the Mass and outside of the tabernacle.

Restoring this remarkable heirloom for its intended purpose will require significant repairs. It will need to have a luna installed which will hold Our Lord's Body for public adoration and veneration. Given the remarkable size of

our monstrance, we will need to have a suitable post fashioned so that Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament may be conducted, and Our Lord may be carried in Eucharistic Procession. The monstrance will also need to be adorned with a cross, to show the relationship of the **Eucharistic Mystery**

to Our Lord's Passion.

PASTOR'S REFLECTION MAY 11, 2025


Jesus said: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." (John 10:27)

This Sunday, May 11, 2025, "Good Shepherd Sunday," is also the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, to fulfill the Lord's instruction, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest." (Matt 9:38; Luke 10:2). Pope St. John Paul II said, "Jesus has a specific task in life for each and every one of us. Each one of us is hand-picked, called by name by Jesus! There is no one among us who does not have a divine vocation!"

While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the ordained ministries (priesthood and diaconate), consecrated life in all its forms (male and female religious life, societies of apostolic life, consecrated virginity), secular institutes in their diversity of services and membership, and to the missionary life. Please pray, especially during Adoration and the Holy Mass and at Holy Communion, that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call. St. John Paul II said, "Some are called audibly by God, but the usual kind of call is internal, through

the inner working of the Spirit."

Today is also Mother's Day, an opportunity to thank God for our mothers and especially for our Blessed Mother, the Immaculate Virgin Mary, Oueen Mother in the Kingdom of God. She so desires to have our permission to be our mother and to help us to follow God's call every day. A simple daily

Why request Mass intentions? The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice [the Mass], so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God" (CCC 1032).

The dead in purgatory can no longer pray for themselves. Pope Francis said that offering Masses for the dead "is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to the most abandoned ones." Masses can also be offered a living person who is sick or suffering; a living person who is celebrating a birthday, anniversary or other special moment in their life; in thanksgiving to God; in thanksgiving for a prayer from a saint; or for a prayer intention (that does not contradict Church teaching). The efficacy or fruitfulness of a Mass in a person's life depends on that person's interior openness to God's will and not merely on the external performance of a sacrament (CCC 2111). We allow normally one intention per Mass, except that two Masses per week may have two intentions.
