
## Welcome! - Bienvenido! - Mabuhay!

#### PASTORAL REFLECTION MAY 18, 2025

Jesus said: "I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another." (John 13:34)

With our new Pope Leo XIV, we have new inspiration to love one another as the Lord Jesus commanded us. Pope Leo began by speaking to us of the peace of Jesus Christ which comes from being united in Him. His papal motto is "In the One [Christ] we are one."

To become one in Christ, we need to become humble and detach ourselves from our egos and from any part of our wills that is not in harmony with the perfect will of Christ. No one is more united with Christ's will than His Mother, the Immaculate Virgin Mary in Heaven. Therefore, the more that we are united with her, the more we will be united with Christ—and one with each other.

That is the purpose of Consecration to Jesus through Mary, or "Marian Consecration." Our parish network (Cathedral, Historic St. Mary's, St. Francis of Assisi) is offering Marian consecration retreats this summer and fall to all people! The first consecration retreat begins on Memorial Day, May 26, as "Day 1," when you can start reading the book 33 Days to Morning Glory (by Fr. Michael Gaitley MIC) or listening to his book on the app Hallow (look for our Cathedral community and/or search for "33 Days to Morning Glory").

We will have an information meeting with a food reception this coming Sunday after the 11:00 a.m. Mass at the Cathedral. Then we will also have optional retreat meetings for six Mondays at Mater Christi Church (40 Hopewell St., Albany) from 6:30-8 pm starting on Memorial Day, May 26 (but you don't have to attend the meetings to consecrate yourself to Mary). The Mass of Consecration will be on the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. June 28, 9:00 a.m. at the Cathedral.

I invite you to pray to the Holy Spirit and ask whether the Lord might be calling you to make a total consecration to Jesus through Mary, a total renewal of your baptismal vows so that you can be totally united with Christ; in Him, we can be one as He and the Father are One.

Why request Mass intentions? The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice [the Mass], so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God" (CCC 1032).

The dead in purgatory can no longer pray for themselves. Pope Francis said that offering Masses for the dead "is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to the most abandoned ones." Masses can also be offered a living person who is sick or suffering; a living person who is celebrating a birthday, anniversary or other special moment in their life; in thanksgiving to God; in thanksgiving for a prayer from a saint; or for a prayer intention (that does not contradict Church teaching). The efficacy or fruitfulness of a Mass in a person's life depends on that person's interior openness to God's will and not merely on the external performance of a sacrament (CCC 2111). We allow normally one intention per Mass, except that two Masses per week may have two intentions.
