

PASTORAL REFLECTION (November 9, 2025, Dedication of the Lateran BASILICA IN ROME)

The Jews said to Jesus, "What sign can you show us for doing this?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up." ... He was speaking about the temple of his **Body**. (John 2:18-22)

Today we celebrate a feast around the world: the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome, the cathedral of the Holy Father, the pope. The Basilica of St. John Lateran was one of the first churches built after the early persecutions and was consecrated by Pope Sylvester on this day in 324 on Lateran Hill, land donated by the Lateran family. This celebration was originally only in Rome but it became global as a sign of unity with the "Holy See," the Diocese of Rome.

The Basilica is the oldest of all the Western churches and is still the Cathedral of the Pope. On the front entrance is inscribed, "Mater et caput omnium ecclesiarum urbis et orbis" ("Mother and head of all the churches of the City and the world"). It is like a mother in that the Church gives birth to children who are adopted by God at baptism and feeds her children with divine food so that they can live forever after death; as Jesus said, "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day." (John 6:53-55) St. John Lateran basilica is also the "Head," as Christ is the Head of His Mystical Body, the Catholic Church.

In our diocese we also celebrate the dedication and consecration of our Cathedral (dedicated November 16, 1852; consecrated November 16, 1902) under the patronage of the Immaculate Conception, which was defined as a dogma 1854. Our new Bishop-elect Mark O'Connell will celebrate Evening Prayer (Vespers) at the Cathedral on December 4 and celebrate his first Mass at the Cathedral as our Bishop on Sunday December 7 at 11:00 a.m. Please pray with me in gratitude for the ministry of Bishop Ed and in hope for the forthcoming shepherding by Bishop Mark.


