

## **PASTORAL REFLECTION** October 5, 2025

The Lord replied, "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would **obey you.**" (Luke 17:6)

Mulberry trees are found in usually dry regions; they wouldn't survive in the sea because the saltwater would kill them. On the other hand, mangrove trees are the only species that can live in the sea, with a fascinating ability to thrive in coastal saltwater. Perhaps the Lord's parable means that for us to be uprooted from dry, complacent spiritual lives and to be "replanted" in the ocean of divine mercy, it requires a change of heart almost as dramatic as changing from one kind of tree to another.

This conversion to trust totally in Jesus is possible if we have faith. October is dedicated to praying the rosary, which deepens our faith. By praying the rosary while contemplating the "mysteries" of Jesus's life and mission, we grow in our relationship with Him who is God the Son of Mary.

Having "Marian closeness" with her son Jesus fosters a natural familial friendship with Him, while allowing ourselves amazement that her son is also God the eternal Creator of all things visible and invisible. Because God created us in His image and saved us by suffering and dying for us, human life is sacred and so deserves respect in every situation, including unborn babies in the womb, elderly grandparents whose care is difficult, refugees of war,

and even people imprisoned for heinous crimes. God desires to save and make holy every human life, no matter how impossible it seems.

Jesus challenges us to respect life at every stage and situation. October is also Respect Life Month. Let's pray the rosary every day this month (even just one mystery daily) and ask the Lord not only for change in the world but first for change inside



ourselves, through faith that begins even as a small mustard seed.
