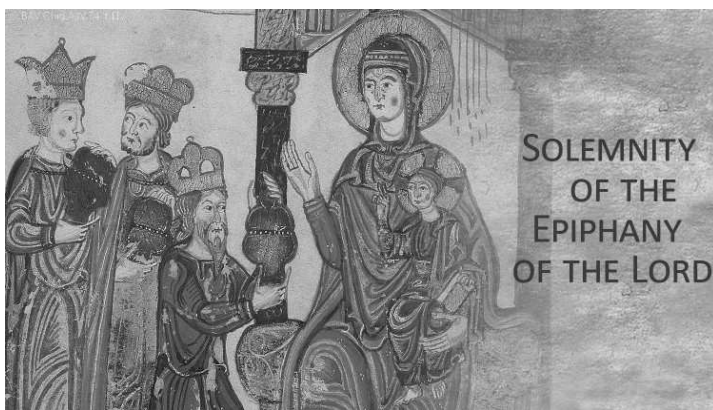

## The Epiphany of the Lord — 4 January 2026



Epiphany in Greek means “manifestation.” In the West, the visit of the Magi is celebrated as the event through which the Lord was “manifested” to the pagans and, therefore, to the world. The Magi “raise their eyes” and set out on a journey, going where it was logical to “seek” a king, in a palace. Their arrival creates a bit of turmoil so much so that King Herod convokes the priests and pharisees.

The Magi set out again following the star, but at a certain point they no longer see it. So strong had their certainty been that the newborn King would be in the palace – a certainty that had momentarily dazzled their eyes to the point that they lost their way. But then, accepting the fact that they had been mistaken, they “convert” themselves, and the star reappears, guiding them toward their goal.

The light of the star always leads to an act of adoration, of bowing before the mystery that has drawn near.

come at least spiritually into my  
heart.  
I embrace You as if You were  
already there and unite myself  
wholly to You. Never permit me to  
be separated from You.

### **PASTOR’S REFLECTION**

**JANUARY 4, 2026**

#### **THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD**

***“He went and dwelt in a town called Nazareth, so that what had been spoken through the prophets might be fulfilled, He shall be called a Nazorean.” (Matthew 2:10-11)***

On this Sunday we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord, which actually refers to three events that reveal that Jesus is the long-awaited Savior of humanity. The first revelation (epiphany) occurs when the wise men (the “magi”) seek out the infant Jesus. The other two revelations occur when Jesus is baptized in the Jordan River (which we celebrate next Sunday) and His first miracle at the wedding feast at Cana.

This Sunday’s Gospel recounts the grand long-awaited moment when the wise men, after studying for years and searching over many miles to find the Messiah, finally arrive at the humble dwelling of the Holy Family and gaze on the one whom they have desired to honor. The infant King is held by Mary his mother as He receives the wise men’s prostrations and treasures. The Mother and Son belong together and are honored together.

It is no accident or mere coincidence that Mary was honored along with her only son, because God is so pleased with her complete trust in Him. May we always try to please God as the wise men did by never neglecting to honor the Mother of God whenever we worship her Son. For Mary is the New Eve and the new “mother of all the living” (Genesis 3:20; John 19:26-27) who are born again by baptism into the mystical Body of her Son.

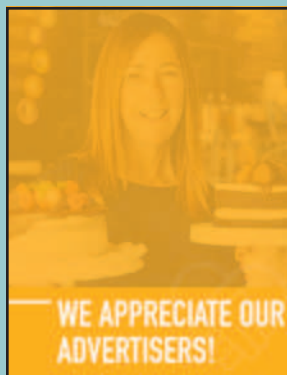

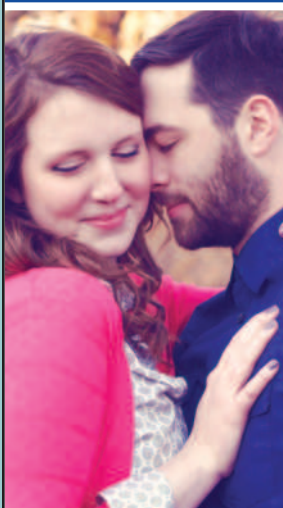
