

From the Rector's Desk...

What is The Historic Albany Network of Parishes?

Bishop Scharfenberger has proposed that parishes minister in networks; a close working together of groups of parishes so that we can more effectively proclaim the Gospel, be better stewards of our valuable and limited human, material and financial resources all of which are in diminishing supply and work toward creating long-term sustainability for all our present parishes. Our network of parishes consists of Cathedral, Historic Saint Mary and Saint Francis of Assisi. To be part of a Network means to move forward together using the strengths of each community for the good of the whole.

What will this practically mean?

* Each of the three parishes *remains canonically distinct*. Parishes are not merging or closing. Each will continue to have separate finances under the care of its own Trustees and Finance Councils as per law.

What will be new?

* Through a process of education and prayerful discernment, members from all three parishes have been formed into ONE Pastoral Council. A Pastoral Council is a consultative body that investigates some aspect of the church's life, ponder it, and recommends its conclusions to the pastor. Ultimately is it a search for wisdom to assist the pastor.

* We are moving to have ONE staff for the Network of parishes working at ONE locality. This will afford all the parishes a savings for salaries and benefits and allow for better communication and a working environment for the staff. When the process is complete, there will be ONE Faith Formation Director, ONE Building & Grounds Manager etc. across the three parishes.

In today's Gospel hear Jesus tell us: *Whoever gives only a cup of cold water*

to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple—Amen, I say to you, he will surely not lose his reward." This week, know that you will be bringing hope
