A new Intra-Parish Pastoral Council announced.

From the Pastor's Desk

The Historic Albany Network of parishes consists of the Cathedral, Historic Saint Mary and Saint Francis of Assisi. How do these parishes serve and carry out the mission of the Church in this part of the City of Albany? While remaining three canonical parishes a broader overview is required to address

the pastoral needs of our area. This will mean setting new and different priorities in a time of limited resources of people, clergy, and finances.

With the reality of only one priest-pastor for all three communities, a more united manner is called for to address our changing situation. I invited members of all three parish councils to enter into a series of sessions of education and discernment to form one intra-parish pastoral council for the network. Though not all were able to participate, the Spirit continues to work through the process. Where there were three councils there will now be one council.

The Church defines a pastoral council as a consultative body that investigates some aspect of the church's life, ponder it, and recommends its conclusions to the pastor. Ultimately is it a search for wisdom, a value that is needed in our changing times.

I am grateful to the parishioners of the three parishes who have served on councils in the past and to those who were able to enter the process of education and discernment. I am grateful to Elizabeth Simcoe, Parish Life Director for Saint Vincent DePaul, for leading these sessions and allowing us to use their parish facilities.

To the larger communities of Saint Francis, Saint Mary and Cathedral, I request your prayers for an openness to the movement of the Holy Spirit on all our parts as we move forward into uncharted waters.
