#### MUSIC MINISTRY ANNOUNCEMENT

#### FORMER ST. JAMES SCHOOL SOLD

16 St. James PI, the site of the former Saint James School has officially sold for \$205,000, to 16 St James PI, LLC. The deal closed on August 30<sup>th</sup>, and the parish netted \$198,000, after closing costs and brokerage fees. As communicated previously, Saint Francis will retain use of the gym for special events, food pantry space, and use of the shared St James lot on weekends. Further, Albany Med Kids will remain in the building, but they are now a tenant of the new owner.

#### **UPDATE: PARKING LOT REPAVING AND EXPANSION**

Repaving of the Saint Francis parking lots has moved and will start on **Friday, September 20**th. **Important:** Parking for weekend Masses will be affected. The Delaware Lot is expected to be finished in time for Mass on Saturday; however, parking will be **unavailable** in the shared St James lot. Additional overflow parking will be available at the laundromat, with their permission. The project includes the full repaving of the Delaware Lot; removal of the fence separating the rectory driveway to expand the lot into that space; reworking of the Delaware Avenue entrance to allow easier entry and exit; repaving of other areas as needed; sealing areas that do not require repaving; and, additional ADA spots, including spaces located closer to the ramp area of the church. Saint Francis will contribute \$25,000 to the cost of the project.
