
## Welcome! - Bienvenido! - Mabuhay!

#### **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd!**

The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception will be offering The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) method of faith formation for the 2025-26 year for children from ages 3 to 9. God is deeply present to very young children, and they are capable of developing both a conscious and intimate relationship with God.



A specially prepared environment, the "atrium," is filled with materials of people, places, and things from Scripture and Liturgy which nurture this relationship between the child and God. The program is organized into three levels: ages 3-6, 6-9, and 9-12. Presentations are designed to draw the child into Biblical and Liturgical themes, whose materials are then available to the children to further absorb the lessons.

The Cathedral will offer a Level I Atrium for children ages 3-6 on Fridays from 4:00-5:30 pm and a Level II Atrium for children ages 6-9 on Fridays from 6:00-7:30 pm. Both sessions will begin September 26.

#### **Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit!**



We are excited to host the International Exhibition of the Eucharistic Miracles of the World as designed by Blessed (soon to be Saint) Carlo Acutis **September 5-7** at each of our four churches (Cathedral, St. Mary's, and St. Francis's two locations). Eucharistic Miracles are extraordinary events or phenomena which manifest the

Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. For example, a consecrated Host may become human heart tissue, a person may be miraculously healed after receiving Jesus in Holy Communion, the power of Christ in the consecrated Host may stop a flood or fire, or in a saint may live solely on the Eucharist for years. Blessed Carlo photographed many of these miracles and designed this exhibit to spread devotion and faith in Jesus in the Most Holy and Blessed Sacrament. Come and witness the love that Jesus has for you. We will have interests for all ages.

#### PASTORAL REFLECTION August 17, 2025

Jesus said, "There is a baptism with which I must be baptized, and how great is my anguish until it is accomplished!" (Luke 12:50)

What is this "baptism" that Jesus must receive? In Mark's Gospel Jesus asks James and John, "Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?" Jesus's "baptism" is His crucifixion and death, which save us from our sins by this ultimate expression of His love for the Father and for the world.

In the Garden of Gethsemane Jesus agonizes over His coming suffering, saying, "Father, if you are willing, take this cup away from me; still, not my will but yours be done." Jesus "was in such agony and he prayed so fervently that his sweat became like drops of blood falling on the ground." (Luke 22:42-44) Yet Jesus also says that He is in great anguish until this suffering is accomplished for us!

Who could ever desire suffering, unless it was out of love for one's beloved? We are beloved by God the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit. If we accept the Father's merciful love, especially in the healing sacrament of Reconciliation and Penance (Confession), the fire from



Christ's Sacred Heart will consume our fears and transform us into saints, burning with love for the eternal Father.

Peace in Jesus through Mary,



"The flames of mercy are burning Me. I desire to pour them out upon human souls. Oh, what pain they cause Me when they do not want to accept them!" (Jesus to St. Faustina, Diary, 1074).
