
Welcome! - Bienvenido! - Mabuhay!

To minister to parishioners of Cathedral, Saint Mary and Saint Francis, we ask your assistance.


If a parishioner is hospitalized and would like a pastoral visit, the Sacraments of Anointing, Confession and/or Holy Communion, please call



the parish offices. **If you are scheduled for surgery**, you can request and receive the Sacrament of the Sick before your admission to the hospital. This will help to avoid emergency calls for a priest when one may not be available.

Note: hospitals have Pastoral Care Offices through which you may request a chaplain or priest and they often have Eucharistic Ministers from area parishes making visits to distribute Holy Communion. Please inquire about the spiritual services afforded by a medical institution.

If parishioners are in nursing homes or homebound and would like a connection with the parish, please call the offices. Due to HIPPA Laws, we are unable to ask nursing homes directly about patients or their spiritual needs. Thank you for helping us serve our community.

Give Us This Day is a monthly publication centered on the Word of God. Drawing inspiration from a multitude of voices, it provides a relevant and trustworthy understanding of Scripture. Whether you have five minutes or a half hour, Give Us This Day supports your desire to pray. Look for copies in the back of the church.

Ordinary Time...Today the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord completes the Christmas Season according to our Catholic tradition and also begins what is called Ordinary Time. A bit of a misnomer in the Christian understanding of time since no time is "ordinary". All time is infused with the presence of God and therefore an opportunity to encounter God. The English translation is a poor rendering of the Latin that simply means "ordinal" i.e. is counting. Outside of the two great liturgical cycles of Advent-Christmas and Lent-Easter the Roman tradition of accounting for the other Sundays was simply to "count" them. Older Catholics will remember Sundays such as "the 15th Sunday after Pentecost" or the "3rd Sunday after Epiphany".

Each Sunday, the Lord's Day, is considered a Solemnity, that is, a Holy Day of festivity celebrating an aspect of the death and resurrection of Jesus. The Lectionary readings set the weekly tone for the homily, the intercessions and the choice of music. The weekly Sunday celebration is "the" identifying mark of the Christian community. What happens each Sunday is the fruit of the week past and the beginning of the week to come. This is not ordinary at all.
