
#### Welcome! - Bienvenido! - Mabuhay!

#### PASTORAL REFLECTION

MAY 25, 2025-Sixth Sunday of Easter

Jesus said: "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." (John 14:26-27)

Jesus links the Holy Spirit with the peace that only God can give. The beautiful reality is that the more that we are closer to the Virgin Mary, the closer we are to the Holy Spirit. St. Louis de Montfort says that "the more the Holy Spirit finds Mary His dear and inseparable spouse in a soul, the more active and powerful He becomes in producing Jesus Christ in that soul and that soul in Jesus Christ." He also says, "When the Holy Spirit finds Mary in a soul, He hastens there and enters fully into it. He gives himself generously to that soul according to the place it has given to His spouse."

This is another reason why consecration to Mary helps us to be most conformed to Christ. The second Vatican Council calls Mary "our mother in the order of grace" and says about her: "Redeemed in a more sublime manner in light of the merits of her Son, and united to him by an intimate and indissoluble bond, she is endowed with the supreme office and dignity of being the Mother of God and therefore the beloved daughter of the Father and the temple of the Holy Spirit, by which gift of sublime grace she far surpasses all other creatures, both in heaven and on earth." (Lumen Gentium) Pope Leo entrusted his "heartfelt appeal" for peace to Mary, "Queen of Peace, that she may present it to the Lord Jesus to obtain for us the miracle of peace."

That is the purpose of Consecration to Jesus through Mary, or "Marian Consecration." Our parish network (Cathedral, Historic St. Mary's, St. Francis of Assisi) is offering Marian consecration retreats this summer and fall to all people! The first consecration retreat begins on Memorial Day, May 26, as "Day 1," when you can start reading the book 33 Days to Morning Glory (by Fr. Michael Gaitley MIC) or

listening to his book on the app Hallow (look for our Cathedral community and/or search for "33 Days to Morning Glory").

We will have optional retreat meetings for six Mondays at Mater Christi Church (40 Hopewell St., Albany) from 6:30-8 pm starting on Memorial Day, May 26 (but you don't have to attend the meetings to consecrate yourself to



Mary). The Mass of Consecration will be on the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, June 28, 9:00 a.m. at the Cathedral.

Why request Mass intentions? The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "From the beginning, the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice [the Mass], so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God" (CCC 1032).

The dead in purgatory can no longer pray for themselves. Pope Francis said that offering Masses for the dead "is the best spiritual help that we can give to their souls, particularly to the most abandoned ones." Masses can also be offered a living person who is sick or suffering; a living person who is celebrating a birthday, anniversary or other special moment in their life; in thanksgiving to God; in thanksgiving for a prayer from a saint; or for a prayer intention (that does not contradict Church teaching). The efficacy or fruitfulness of a Mass in a person's life depends on that person's interior openness to God's will and not merely on the external performance of a sacrament (CCC 2111). We allow normally one intention per Mass, except that two Masses per week may have two intentions.

#### **CONSECRATION TO MARY!**

Starting Memorial Day, Monday May 26 until June 28, Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. We will use the book 33 Days to Morning Glory or the app "Hallow" (search for "33 Days" and the Cathedral network).

Six weekly Monday meetings start on "Day 1," May 26, 6:30-8 pm, at Mater Christi Parish. All are welcome! (You do not have to attend the meetings to make your consecration.)
